RM	Edinburgh	Royal Mail (sponsor's mark)	Reproduction items, late 20 <sup>th</sup> and early 21 <sup>st</sup> centuries – year 2000 items with millennium mark. New entry created October 2008.

RP	Birmingham	Robert Pringle	Made the pillar box stamp boxes.
S&B <sup>M</sup>	Chester	Smith & Bartlam	Seen 1906. New entry created October 2008.
SB & Sons Ltd	Birmingham	S Blanckensee & Sons Ltd	
S& C <sup>o</sup>	Birmingham	<i>Possibly</i> Sydney & Co	Purse-style cases early 20 <sup>th</sup> century. New entry created October 2008.

SI Ld	Chester / Birmingham	Stokes & Ireland Ltd	Various two compartment hinged lid boxes. Three compartment hinged lid box also known (added October 2007). Birmingham added to the Assay Office entry October 2007.
